Most of the zoo's animals can be seen enjoying the winter season, but if you're feeling a little chilly, warm up with a visit to the Faces of the Rainforest exhibit. During the holidays, don't miss the return of the Holiday Lights Spectacular. On select nights from Nov. 26, 2021–Jan. 2, 2022, walk along paths featuring festive larger-than-life luminous displays and more than 1.5 million illuminated lights.

The museum celebrates and values the importance of play, while embracing a wide range of learning styles and forms of expression.

The state's first dedicated virtual reality arcade/lounge features nearly 100 experiences to choose from, so you'll never run out of things to do. Play alongside friends to make your way out of a virtual escape room or go it alone and save the world from an alien invasion.

# FINE ART FUN FOR EVERYONE

Just steps from the Providence River on the campus of the Rhode Island School of Design (RISD), the **RISD Museum** (risdmuseum.org) is one of the country's most renowned art museums and a must-visit for any art lover. Boasting a collection of more than 100,000 works of art and design, visitors can discover 2,300 pieces or so on display at any given time. The museum's collection features an array of prominent artists and designers including Picasso, Monet, Manet, Chanel, Andy Warhol and Kara Walker.

Exhibits are continuously rotating in and out of the museum, so even if you've previously visited, you're sure to catch something new once you return. Some of the latest exhibitions on view include "Any Distance Between Us," "On the Surface" and "Raid the Icebox Now With Paul Scott." They'll be joined by "Shahzia Sikander's Extraordinary Realities" and "Drawing Closer, Four Hundred Years of Drawing From the RISD Museum." Exhibitions always on view include the Ancient Egyptian Galleries, Ancient Greek and Roman Galleries, Asian Art Galleries, Modern and Contemporary Galleries, and more.

A typical self-guided tour spans about two hours but you could easily spend more than half a day browsing these extensive collections. If you need a boost of energy during your visit, head over to **Bolt Coffee Co.** (boltcoffeeco.com) located within the museum for a fresh cup of coffee and a small bite.

The RISD Museum is open Tuesday through Sunday and is closed on Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, New Year's Eve and New Year's Day. Advance ticket purchase and masks are required at this time to help ensure the safety of museum staff and visitors. Admission is free on Sundays and after 5 p.m. on Thursdays and Fridays (5–7 p.m.).

It's time to once again raise the curtain as live performances return to Providence. From original shows and Broadway productions to comedians and concerts, there's something for everyone nearly every night of the week.

The **Providence Performing Arts Genter** (ppacri.org) is an architectural gem located in the heart of Downtown. From premier musical acts and Broadway shows, to comedians and even family-friendly specials, there's always something for all types of crowds. Highlights from this upcoming season include "Hamilton," "The Prom," "Alton Brown Live: Beyond the Eats," "Pretty Woman" and "RENT."

Just a few blocks away, **The VETS** (thevetsri.com) hosts an array of performances, including the Philharmonic, ballet, comedians and family shows. On Dec. 9 don't miss the return of "Black Violin," an electrifying show combining classical string arrangements with modern beats. Also in December, Festival Ballet Providence, the state's resident ballet company, brings the holiday classic "The Nutcracker" to The VETS for the first time with a brand-new production featuring magnificent sets and costumes, plus inventive new choreography.

The Tony Award-winning **Trinity Rep** (trinityrep.com) kicks off its return to the stage with the annual performance of "A Christmas Carol." The production is reimagined each year, so don't skip out because you think you know the story. Featuring the talents of a resident acting company, each thoughtfully crafted season offers productions that exemplify both the intimacy and spectacle that can only be found in theater.



You never know what you're going to find at the **Columbus Theatre** (columbustheatre.com), a beautifully restored venue known for eclectic live performances, film screenings and community events. This season's lineup includes incomparable comedian and actress Maria Bamford, the side-splitting interactive improv "Tinder Live! With Lane Moore," and "Puddles Pity Party," featuring Puddles the clown's melancholy melodies.

The Wilbury Theatre Group (thewilburygroup.org) continues to engage the community in thoughtprovoking conversation through original works, new spins on classics and adventurous playmaking. They'll debut a new theater space, the Wilbury Theatre at WaterFire Arts Center, this fall where they will continue to deliver a diverse array of innovative live theater. This season will include the East Coast premiere of "Lifted" and world premiere of "AntigonX."
